

## Art 12 Project submission Deadlines – REVISED May 16 /06

Most of you have demonstrated that you are responsible and organized enough to meet deadlines, BRAVO!. Others are struggling with this – some chronically. Inability to meet deadlines will have adverse impacts in most all contexts. Everyone is very busy and all of our time is valuable, as such, it deserves to be respected.

This document has been created to ensure that all know what is expected in Art 12.

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***Please put these dates in your day planner.***

**May 4:** Advanced critique day for all artworks inspired by the artist researched for your essays. This is an excellent opportunity to get mid-process feedback. Those who succeed to have their projects **completed** by this date will **receive a 10% bonus** on their mark.

**May 9<sup>th</sup>:** Presentations commence. If you miss your assigned presentation date and you have not contacted the school or Mr. Syme to make arrangements, you unfortunately forgo your opportunity to present.

**On the CLASS PRIOR to your presentation.** Please submit a one page summary of your artist, including a few images of their work and some basic summary notes. Be clear, use subtitles.

**May 15<sup>th</sup>:** All essays due. This is a hard deadline. *(NOW PAST DUE)*

**May 30<sup>th</sup>:** All Artworks from inspired Artist Due. This is a hard deadline.

**June 1<sup>st</sup>:** Organized collection of class presentation Notes Due.

**June 7<sup>th</sup>:** Advance critique day of final artwork. Bonus marks to students 100% complete by this date.

**June 22<sup>nd</sup>:** Final Artwork due / Critique & SKETCHBOOK 100% complete. This is a hard deadline.

**Your May 30<sup>th</sup> deadline** is just that, a deadline. The project must be submitted for assessment at the beginning of class on the day the project is due. For those that cannot meet the deadline and have **not** made prior arrangement, the project will not be accepted.

Your Final Art work is Due June 22<sup>nd</sup>, your scheduled exam day. I will have no time to mark anything past in after your scheduled exam time. Not having your art work and sketchbook in on time will be like missing a final exam – earning 0%

**Unable to meet a deadline or to attend class on a day that a project is due?** In any circumstance where a project is due and the project nor the student can attend class, Mr. Syme or the school **MUST** be notified before the class commences. If alternate arrangements need to be made, they need to be made in consultation with the Mr. Syme prior to the assigned deadline. If a class is missed due to illness, the project must be submitted by 9am on the first day you return to school accompanied by a note from home excusing the missed deadline.

The assumption is that, if by a deadline, a student has made no effort to make alternative arrangements with Mr. Syme, nor can he or she demonstrate the project has even been started by the posted deadline, then he or she had no intention of completing a project for the deadline.
