OVERVIEW

- One of his first published works (1883)
- Progressive for its time
 - Author asserting his presence
 - Pointing out of clichés
 - Explaining use of language
- Comical but serious



NAMES

Cherviakov → worm

Brizzhalov → bryzgat (to spray), briuzzhat (to grumble)



THEMES

- Acceptance
- Apologizing
- Social and political structures in Russia



ACCEPTANCE

- Need to please and be accepted by others
- Cannot exist without it
- Dictates our actions and lives



APOLOGIZING

- A lost art
- Often unnecessary and repetitious
- Can become annoying and people begin to ignore it
- Lead to low self-respect



SOCIAL AND POLITICAL STRUCTURES IN RUSSIA

Classism

- Brizzhalov = officer; higher rank than Cherviakov
- Cherviakov = lowly government clerk
