- Victoria

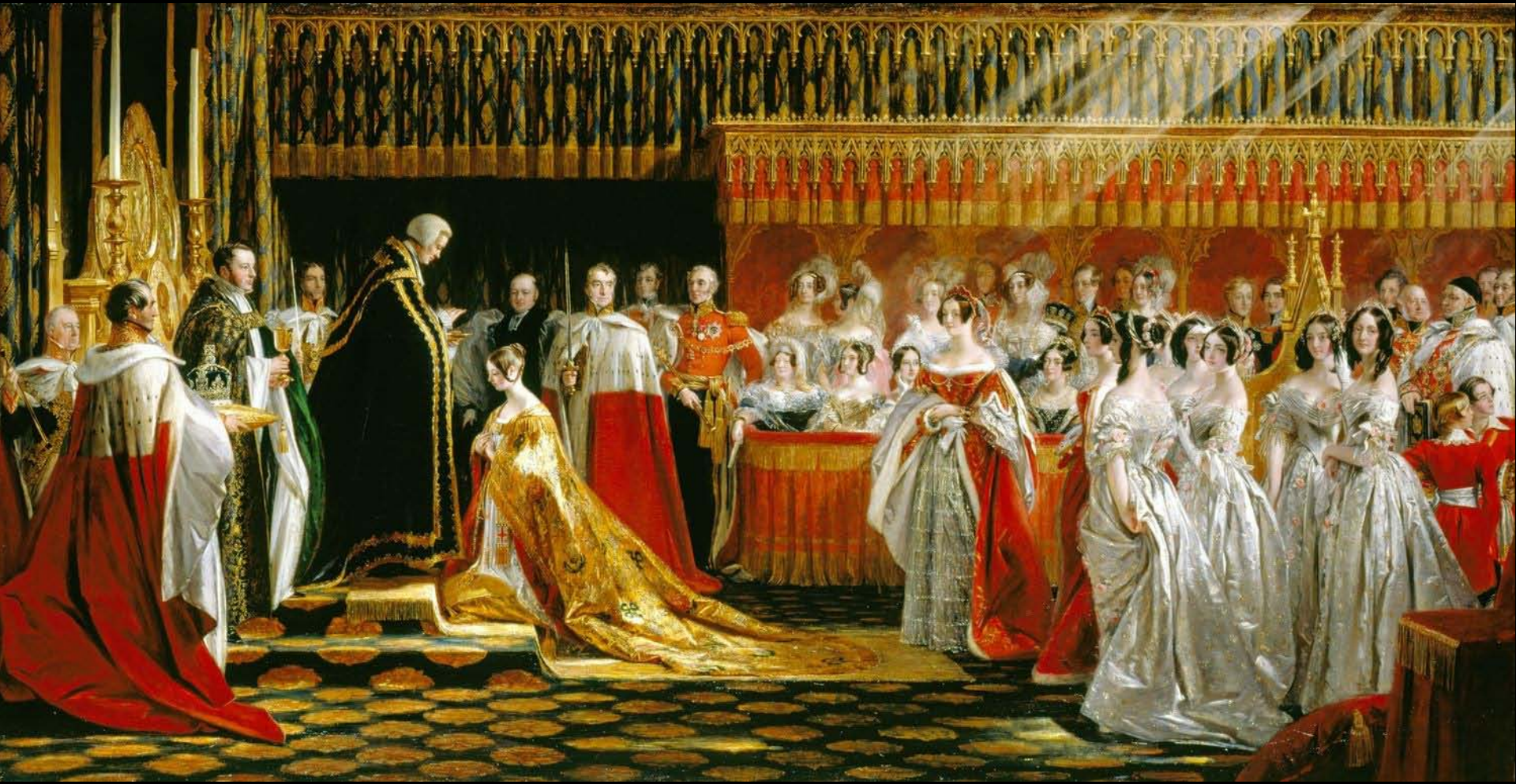


# Her Mother and Conroy
