

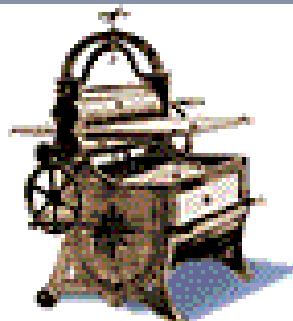
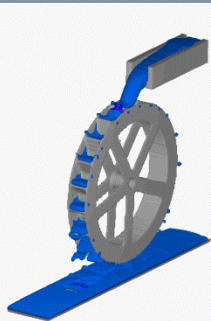

Pre-Industrial Society





- Lasted until the mid 1700's
- Primarily agricultural economy
- Limited production (artisanal vs mass production) and variation of social class



- Limited division of labour
- Few had any opportunity to see/hear anything outside of their own village
- Society vs capitalism
 - Societies formed inside rural communities
 - Capitalism developed in urban areas



Industrial Revolution



- Printing Press (1450's)
- Revolution – 1760 – 1820/1840 (ish)
- English population 1801 - 8.3 million
1850 - 16.8 million
1901 - 30.5 million



- Textiles – looms had steam/water power
- Steam – increasing efficiency (1/5-1/10 the amount of fuel required)
- Iron making – replaced coke for charcoal
